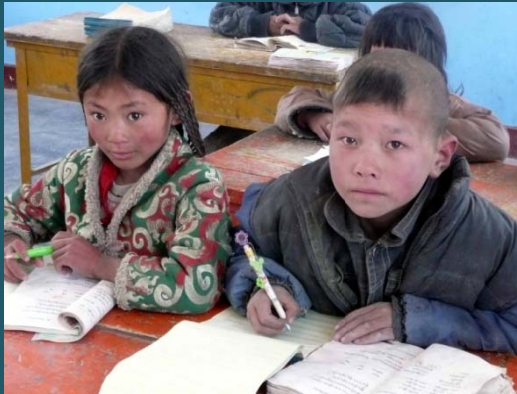

Our 7<sup>th</sup> Annual Celebration is held to honor our community and raise visibility about the core issues we address. With your generous support:

- The Children's Fund supported over 300 village school children in three counties.
- Over 600 teachers attended a bilingual and teaching methodology training.
- Rural school children from 196 Tibetan primary schools in three counties have reading materials in their native Tibetan language teaching them about their history and culture.
- More than 6,000 women received health education training.
- Trained 20 village women to be Community Midwives.
- Created Tibetan-language public health education and training materials for low-literate rural women and Tibetan Maternal and Child Health System Resource Textbooks for health professionals.
- Facilitated regional conferences on women's health.
- We are raising money for scholarships for Tibetan women to attend postgraduate school or medical school.
- We will soon open the doors to the first independent Tibetan Natural Birth and Health Training Center in Tibet.
